1. Rights of Public Entity

The Directorate of Education, Arts and Culture (Zambezi Regional Council) reserves the right:

2. Preparation of Quotations

10. Scope of Services, Specifications and Performance Standards

However, evaluation will be carried out as per the defined scope. Quotations shall cover all costs of labour, materials, equipment, overheads, profits and all associated costs for performing the services, and shall include all duties. The whole cost of performing the services shall be included in the items stated, and the cost of any incidental services shall be deemed to be included in the prices quoted.
