

SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Rights of Public Entity

The Zambezi Regional Council reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per item, or
- (b) to accept or reject any quotation; and
- (c) to cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the items mentioned in Section III by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) The Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for *Bid Securing declaration*
- (b) The List of Goods and Price Schedule Section III;
- (c) The Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and
- (d) Any other attachment deemed appropriate.

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Sealed Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

3. Validity of Quotations

The Quotation validity period shall be 30 days from the date of submission deadline.

4. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should:

- (a) Have a valid company Registration Certificate certified copy;
- (b) Have an original valid good Standing Tax Certificate or certified copy;
- (c) Have an original valid good Standing Social Security Certificate or certified copy;
- (d) Have a valid certified copy of Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, proof from Employment Equity Commissioner that bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998;
- (e) have a valid certified copy of certificate indicating SME Status (for Bids reserved for SMEs);
- (f) [public entity to select appropriate] Submit bid valid signed Bid-securing Declaration.
- (g) Document filled in black ink
- (h) No eraser fluid used
- (i) Initial all the pages and corrections
- (j) Stamp where necessary
- (k) Attach a quotation.

Sealing and Marking of Quotations

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to Zambezi Regional Council with the Bidder's name and contact information at the back of the envelope.

5. Submission of Quotations

Quotations should be deposited in the quotation/Bid box **located at Zambezi Regional Council building, ground floor, not later than 10H00 on the 12 March 2026. Quotation by post should reach Zambezi Regional Council, Procurement Management Unit, Private Bag 5002 Katima Mulilo, attention Mr. Abraham Shikoyeni** by the same date and time at latest. Late quotations will be rejected.

Quotations received by e-mail will not be considered.

6. Opening of Quotations

Quotations will be opened internally by the Public Entity immediately after the closing time referred to in instruction 5 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the bidders, the amount quoted, the presence or absence of a Bid Securing Declaration, will be submitted to the Public Entity and available to any bidder on request within three working days of the Opening.

7. Evaluation of Quotations

The Public Entity shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of price or ownership cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.

8. Technical Compliance

Bidders shall submit along with their quotation's documents, catalogues and any other literature to substantiate compliance with the required specifications and to qualify deviations if any with respect to Public Entity's requirements.

The Specifications, Performance Requirements and Compliance Sheet details the minimum specifications of the goods/items to be supplied. The specifications have to be met but no credit will be given for exceeding the specifications.

9. Prices and Currency of Payment

Prices shall be fixed in Namibian Dollars.

The Bidder having submitted the lowest evaluated responsive quotation and qualified to supply the goods/items and related services shall be selected for award of contract. Award of contract shall be by issue of a Purchase Order in accordance with terms and conditions contained in Section VI: Contract Agreement and General Conditions of Contract.

10. Award of Contract

The Bidder having submitted the lowest evaluated responsive bid and qualified to supply the items and related services shall be selected for award. Award shall be by issue of a purchase Order in Accordance with the terms and conditions contained in VI: Contract and General Condition of Contract
